

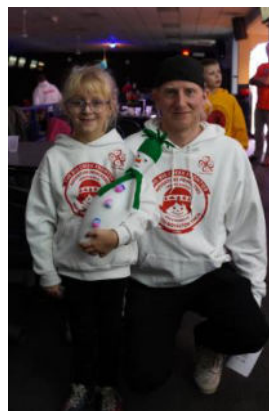
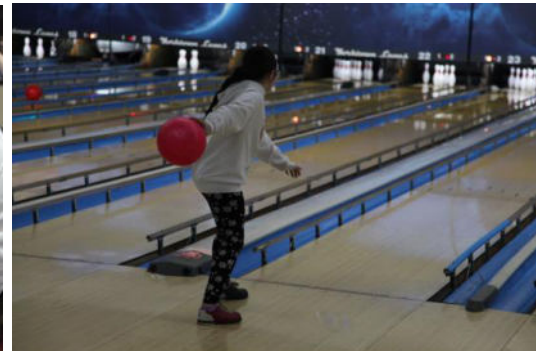

So, you see some cool patches on other princesses or dad's vests and want to know how to get them?

Well here is your guide!:

Feather Patches:



These patches indicate how many years you have been in Adventure Princesses. You get a new one each year at Induction.

Fluff Raiders:



These patches are earned for fluff raids. See more information near the end of the Running Waters.

Princess Interviews:



These patches are earned by completing the Princess Interview in the Running Water. (See form for more details)

4 Part Wagon Wheel:

The 4 part Wagon Wheel build-a-patch is earned by completing 4 unique tasks either with your outpost or during Frontier events:

Health & Safety - This patch is earned by doing something to learn about health and safety such as: Going to fire station, going to a police station, learning first aid, etc...

Heritage - This patch is earned by learning about culture that came before you. Examples can include: Canal Visitor Center, Historic Homesteads, flag retirement,, etc...

Community Service - This patch is earned by giving back to your community. Examples can include: picking up trash in parks, planting trees, serving food to the homeless, making holiday cards for a local nursing home, etc...

Fluff & Fun - This patch is earned by doing a non Frontier event you plan with your outpost and families. Examples can include: Throwing a swim party or game night, have a cook out, go to the zoo, go to a sports game, etc...

All you need to do to collect your patches is to send photos and a description of your activity to either the Trail Bosses or Awards Makers and we will get you your patches!

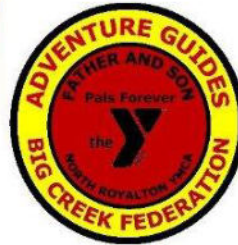

Adventure Princesses Cardboard Boat Regatta Rules/Race Procedures

Contest Rules:

Open to all Adventure Princesses, Senior Princesses, Adventure Guides, Trail Blazers & Dads

- Boat can carry 1-3 passengers.
- Boat must be made of 1/8 inch wafer type cardboard (typical cardboard box material) only. No additional flotation objects (tubes, rubber tires, "noodles", etc) are permitted. This will be STRICTLY enforced.
- No use of fasteners, sealers or any other materials will be allowed e.g. you cannot paint the boat to seal it only use duct tape.
- Boat must be no longer than 6 feet and no wider than 3 feet.
- Hand paddling only. Use of feet in the water to kick will result in disqualification. e.g. you cannot use a raft to do a free-style stroke. If your feet are in the water, likely you will be disqualified.
- No paddles of any kind allowed. No taping of hands.
- All cardboard must be covered with duct tape. No exposed cardboard inside or outside of boat. Exposed cardboard will result in not being able to race (this is a cleanliness/safety issue).
- All participants are required to remove the remains of their boat from the premises immediately after their race. Boats are not to be left in the water to see how long they will float. The boats must be thrown away appropriately, there are potential fines/fees if cardboard boats remain.
Do not leave your boat for someone else to throw in the dumpster.
- Participants who have been disqualified are to remove their boats from the water immediately upon being notified of disqualification.
- Participants are to get out of the pool immediately after completion of the race and carry their boat from the premises.
- Racers are to arrange for disposal of their boat prior to race day.
- Once the event starts no modifications or additions to boats are permitted.

Race Procedures:

Race will start from the deep end of the pool. Boats are to be placed in between each of the starting blocks. If enough boats are present, multiple heats will be run. Participants will set their boats in the water, once the whistle blows board the boat and start the race..

Participants are to **hand paddle only** down to the other end of the pool, and touch the side of the pool. Only one person needs to touch the side of the pool. The race is not finished until the participant touches the other side of the pool, a boat touching the side of the pool is not considered finishing. Participants must remain in their boat the entire time they are moving forward, if a participant falls out of the boat the boat may not advance until they are back in.

Participants are not allowed to travel down the side of the pool using the edge of the pool or lane dividers to propel the boat. Using the edge of the pool or lane dividers to propel the boat will result in disqualification.

Prizes: will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place for the Frontier / Best Decorated Boat 1st only for the Frontier / and Dad Race 1st only for the Frontier

Why the Birch Tree Wears Slashes

From the writings of Frank Bird Linderman

It was blowing a gale and snow was being driven in fine flakes across the plains when the young man went to the lodge for a story. Every minute the weather was growing colder, and a severe early fall storm them. The wind seemed to add to the good nature of his host, War Eagle, as he filled and passed me the pipe.



"This is the night I was to tell you about the Birch-Tree, and the wind will help to make you understand," said War Eagle. "Of course," he continued, "this all happened in the summer-time when the weather was warm, very warm. Sometimes, you know, there are great winds in the summer, too.



"It was a hot day, and OLD-man (God) was trying to sleep, but the heat made him sick. He wandered to a hilltop for air; but there was no air. Then he went down to the river and found no relief. "*'Ho! Birch-Tree, won't you mind me? Bend and break! I tell you,'* but all the Birch-Tree would do was to bend. It bent to the ground; it bent double to please OLD-man, but it would not break."

"*'Blow harder, wind!'* cried OLD-man, *'blow harder and break the Birch-Tree.'* The wind tried to blow harder, but it couldn't, and that made the thing worse, because OLD-man was so angry he went crazy. *'Break! I tell you—break!'* screamed OLD-man to the Birch-Tree.

"*'You won't, hey?'* cried OLD-man, and he rushed at the Birch-Tree with his hunting-knife. All up and down the trunk of the tree OLD-man slashed, until the Birch was covered with the knife slashes.
